- Update on presentation to UBC Exec: how to sustain smoke-free campus, what does compliance look like, marijuana legalization
- Deferred to next meeting.
- 4.2 Input from campus community re: smoke-free & marijuana legalization D. Zinz (10 min)
 - Vehicles for campus community input so far:
 - Students for sensible drug policy
 - o Marijuana panel "Curious About Cannabis" February 2018
 - o Marijuana policy committee (led by University Counsel)
 - Substance use network
 - UBC-wide wellbeing survey (re: tobacco use)
 - Marijuana policy will be UBC-wide policy rather than campus-specific
 - No intent to restrict more significantly than law allows for; restrictions will likely centre around intoxication
 - Residence rooms likely to remain smoke-free
 - More education required on campus re: cannabis use, safety (i.e. edibles), & policy
 - Smoke-free campus concerns
 - o Wildfire risk on wooded areas
 - Difficulty of enforcing especially in regards to non-campus community (transit exchange)
 - o Potential duty to accommodate addiction, medical marijuana, etc.
 - Supporting community (i.e. providing cessation resources, etc.) at odds with enforcement-based approach
- 4.3 Needles/sharps on campus

- Not feasible to have sharps in every bathroom on campus;
 - Cost of installation and maintenance (sharps collection)
 - Most containers would be very low-use
 - o looking for location where containers will see the most use
- Now that transit exchange is in place gathering data on where best place to host sharps container might be; data so far is unclear
- Current removal process call non-emergency dispatch line; Security will remove following proper procedures (gloves, tongs etc.)
