Staff Accident/Incident Reports - Injury Reported - Aug 27 - Sept 23:

<u>Aug 29th</u>: A worker was walking down a hallway when she slipped on a puddle of liquid and fell. She suffered minor injuries as a result of the fall. She immediately contacted the custodial contractor who responded by cleaning the spill. The custodial contractor subsequently determined that a hose in a janitorial closet sink had come loose resulting in water flowing into the hallway. The contractor retightened the hose and no subsequent leaks have been noted. No first aid treatment was sought and no WorkSafe claim has resulted from this incident.

The vehicle was then driven down the ramp between SCI and LIB. The vehicle then proceeded to cross University Way in the crosswalk. The vehicle then proceeded driving down the lot: F, Commons field pedestrian walkway towards Purcell. Security lost track of the vehicle after that point.
