

**HAZARDOUS MATERIAL DISPOSAL**  
**Uncontaminated Pathological Material**


Uncontaminated pathological material includes uncontaminated animal carcasses/parts/tissues as well as uncontaminated fungi, insects and parasites. It does NOT include preserved animal specimens.

- Do not autoclave
- Remove any catheters, tubing, clips, tags before packaging
- Collect in 20 litre red pails supplied by RMS.
- Store in freezer for pickup.
- Do not mix contaminated and uncontaminated pathological materials.
- Affix Biological Waste Tag (available from RMS) and check box labelled *Uncontaminated Pathological Animal*
- Register your waste through the Hazardous Waste Inventory System (HWIS) at <https://cwis.rms.ubc.ca/wisoc/login.aspx>

Prior to pick up please ensure:

- exterior of container/bag is not be contaminated
- tag is clearly marked
