Other	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • COVID update • - self-declaration phase – rapid testing now only available to those who are directed based on the self-declarations; concerns have been raised: 1. Folks who don't want to declare, showing up to the clinic may be perceived as a kind of outing/declaration 2. So far, people have been polite but HSE are preparing students working at clinic for variety of situations • -more accurate if tested twice per week, but many things are not clear yet • Over summer about 800 tests, only 3 positive, in the last week • Clinics have slowed down significantly since change was made – no longer testing anyone on campus, or sports teams • If numbers continue to be low, may re-open up to anyone who wants it, who is asymptomatic • H&SD – rapid testing for their students attending labs on in-person learning, will have to purchase, treated as private • Resistance to rapid testing, or non-compliance – go to HR for direction on those cases • Masks in study rooms and shared spaces? Interior health order is rescinded, now under provincial orders again, will follow those for indoor spaces. Masks must be worn in all public places but are not required in contained spaces such as study rooms as long as the door is closed. • Security presence at building entrances, coaching, encouraging compliance with mask-wearing • No food or beverages inside classes anymore, to ensure mask wearing at all times • Student requests for mask exemptions go through DRC; staff requests go through HR (WRAP)
