The patient continued to threaten the writer and nurses to become physical with them. The patient then punched the writer in the face and hit another nurse in the back with a pillow. |

When the paid student<br>disconnected a tubing from the microfluidic device, the pressure<br>within the system wasn't completely released, causing a small<br>amount (~0.02 mL) of KOH to splash on their face and right eye.<br>The paid student immediately turned on the eye wash station<br>nearby to rinse their eyes for 15 minutes under running water.<br>The KOH might have caused chemical burns and eye irritation.<br>The paid student sought medical attention immediately. The<br>doctor checked over the eye and there was no eye damage<br>observed. Antibiotic eyedrops were provided to prevent infection.  |
