Other	<ul> <li>First Aid Program changes – follow-up after last meeting's discussion</li> <li>Would we be considered a remote campus or not, language around roof tops and confined spaces</li> <li>Going forward we will have more coverage on site</li> <li>JOHSC structure – proposal to make slight change</li> <li>Current structure – may need to change where the library sits – put it within the AVPS committee due to the</li> <li>Committee voted to move Library under AVPS</li> <li>Narcan (naloxone) cabinets on campus and tie-in with AEDs</li> <li>30 cabinets with 60 kits from Province</li> <li>28 are installed and dosages have been given to all patrol staff on campus to keep with them</li> <li>EFRT also carries Narcan</li> <li>All residences have a cabinet within various areas</li> <li>Some have also be put in administration buildings</li> <li>Would like to have narcan, AED's and emergency call boxes together</li> <li>Working through the budget process for providing more naloxone to campus</li> <li>Note – opening the box causes and alarm but it does not contact security so ensure that security is called if needed</li> <li>Towardtheheart.com has a good video on how to use Narcan</li> <li>Communication – posters have been posted and residence has done a very good job of informing their students</li> <li>Annual campus immunization clinics</li> <li>Using ballroom and Nechako, same timing as last year, aprox. 1400 doses</li> <li>Can have COVID vaccines as well, need to determine how many we will need – 500?</li> <li>Scheduled appointments rather all drop ins - don't typically turn anyone away even if they haven't booked</li> <li>Will include families – 12 and over</li> </ul>
